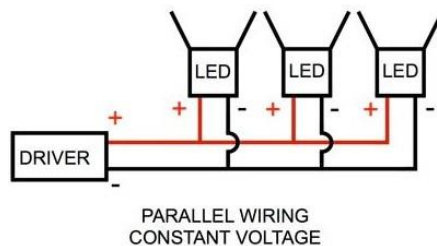
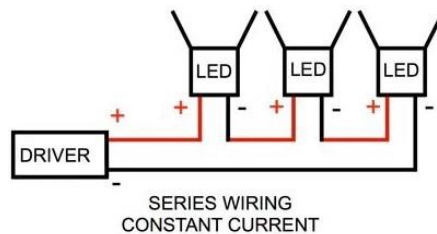


WARNING

- If the power supply is from a **constant current** driver, then you must wire the circuit **in series**. You will damage the fittings if wired in parallel.



- Only connect **one circuit** to **one constant current** driver.
- For any circuit wired **in series** only turn the mains power on once **all the correct number of fittings have been connected** to the driver. **Any deviation from this rule will damage the fittings.** See our online driver calculator for guidance.
- Always **turn off the power supply completely** before disconnecting or reconnecting any fitting in the circuit. **Any deviation from this rule will damage the fittings.**
- Remove **all thermal insulation** a minimum of 150mm away from any fitting.
